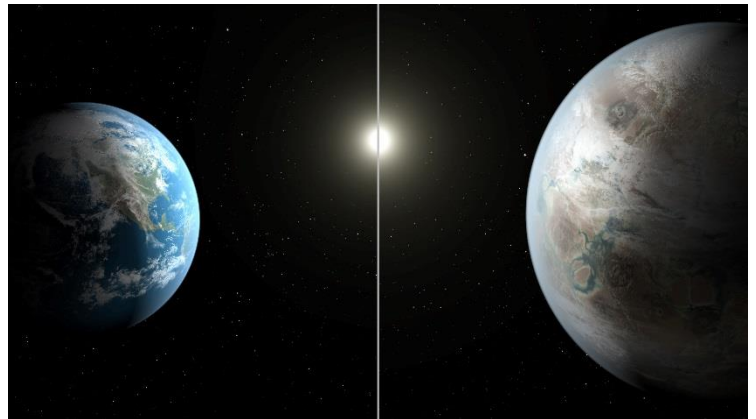


**The search for Earth's twin planet**
